# The Figure in Movement: Expressive Drawing

A three-day, intensive and experimental drawing course with 2 tutors, who specialise in drawing and creating inventive processes to encourage fresh ways of looking and creating images. Emily and Katie share their love of drawing as a process of exploration and discovery. This exciting course is a wonderful and unique opportunity for artists to explore the breadth and depth of drawing: working with charcoal, ink, simple animation, collage, installation, working on both very large and small scale, different surfaces and in collaboration with the model and other the artists.

The large space of the studio will be transformed using installations for the figure to move through and interact with. The walls will be generously covered with rolls of paper for the atists to work on. All the materials will be provided during the course. Over the three days students will create many drawings and importantly have the freedom to really push into the creative process; taking risks and playing to find out what they love about working from the figure and what the versatility of the materials can offer. The course will culminate in finished work as well as lots of material from which paintings can be made in the future. The following week in the sudio there will be a Figure Painting Course. This drawing course would be fantastic preparation for the painting course. Why not come to both?!

### **TIMETABLE**

## Day one: Wednesday 28th of May 2025

The course starts promptly at 9.30 so please make sure that you arrive no later than 9.15 to find your space and have a cup of coffee. Katie and Emily will welcome you and introduce the course. Line and movement will be the theme of the day.

The day will end with a review of the work and finish promptly at 4.30 pm.

### Day Two: Thursday 29th of May 2025

There will be a slide show at the beginning of the day. The focus of the day will be on developing the large scale pieces and also working in the opposite extreme on tiny images; exploring the physicality of the poses, scale and the abundant possibilities of layers.

### Day Three: Friday 30<sup>th</sup> of May 2025

At the beginning of the final day Katie and Emily invite students to push still further and dare to work even more playfully. This might mean collaborating with other artists, the model and using surfaces and materials in unconventional ways. For the second part of the day Katie and Emily will give individual tutorials and encourage each student to dare to keep playing and exploring within a theme that has come from the work. Each student will hopefully leave energised, inspired, more courageous and with armfuls of work – some resolved and some ready for developing further.

#### **COURSE MATERIALS**

The studio will provide all the materials that you need for the course.

THE SEAWHITE SHOP: The shop is open Monday – Friday from 9 am - 4.45 pm and 9am – 12 noon on Saturdays. All the products they sell are amazing value, at warehouse prices and so you might want to stock up with sketchbooks and materials while you are on the course.
